




- Provides full-bandwidth playback of native Dolby Digital Plus and Dolby TrueHD signals decoded inside the player.

Simply connect the HDMI™ output on your HD DVD player to an HDMI input on your A/V receiver. In most instances, the HDMI cable can transport high-definition digital video in addition to multichannel audio signals.

Six- or Eight-Channel Analog (External Input)

Offers full-bandwidth playback of native Dolby Digital Plus and Dolby TrueHD signals decoded inside the player.



Use RCA-type audio cables to connect the external audio outputs on your HD DVD player to the external audio inputs on your A/V receiver.

NOTE: If your A/V receiver does not perform bass management of external audio input signals and you have a satellite-subwoofer playback system, be sure to consult the owner's manual of your HD DVD player to confirm that it performs bass management.
